CROATIAN UNITS IN THE GERMAN FORCES

With the recent advent of the Croatian Philatelic Society and the accompanying surge of interest in the "Kroat" units of the Wehrmacht, several requests have been received for information on the Feldpost numbers used by these units. The following information was drawn from U.S. Military Intelligence records on microfilm #60-15 (German Army Order of Battle) and from the Deutsches Rotes Kreuz Suchdienst Vermisstenbildliste in conjunction with U.S. Government microfilm series T-78 (Feldpostübersicht). While the information presented should assist in identification of Croatian unit covers, it should be noted that Feldpost numbers were sometimes reassigned to other units (particularly when a unit ceased to exist). The actual usage periods of the numbers following is an extensive study in itself and is beyond the scope of this article. Questions pertaining to usage dates will be gladly answered by the writer on request as time permits. Units are listed here-with as they appear in the German records and a translation of terms/abbreviations is provided at the conclusion.

Unit History

Consisted of Croatian personnel with German cadres. Called a German-Croatian (deutsche-kroatische) division and referred to as "Teufels" (Devil's) Division.

Winter 42-43: Formed by reconstitution and expansion of Croatian Inf Rgt 369 which had operated in Russia under 100th Jag Div and was destroyed at Stalingrad.

Spring 43: In Croatia. Employed on line of communications duties and constantly engaged against partisans in Croatia. Suffered from continuous desertion of its personnel.

Late 44: Yugoslavia, Mostar area.

Unit History

Spring '43: Began forming as mountain division with Bosnian, Moslem and Croat volunteers and a cadre from SS Freiwilligen-Geb.-Div. "Prinz Eugen". At first called "BH" (Bosnian-Herzegovinian) division. Many Moslems and some Christians from Croat National Army were forced into the division when recruiting of volunteers lagged. Personnel were considered very unreliable and subject to desertion.

Sept. '43: In south-central France.

Nov. '43: In Lower Silesia.

Dec. '43: In Austria.

Jan. '44: Transferred to Slovenia.

Dec. '44: Transferred to the southern Hungarian sector of the eastern front.

While U.S. Intelligence microfilms indicate that the 23rd SS Geb Div was dissolved late in 1944, the German records indicate that remnants were reformed into the new "31. SS Freiwilligen Grenadier Div Kama". This is borne out (as can be noted below) by these division's corresponding elements having, for the most part, the same Feldpost numbers. The U.S. Intelligence reports list the 31st Division as follows:
